

## **GwynneSpeed Online Shopping Terms & Conditions**

### **Booking**

On purchasing an experience from GwynneSpeed Rallying, a gift voucher will be issued in a presentation box. Gift vouchers are valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issue – validity can be extended by prior agreement.

To book on a course, the participant must book a course within the 12 month validity of the voucher by calling our booking line, 0871 230 9500 and quoting the voucher number.

Experience details will then be posted to the participant with a map and detailed directions of how to get to the rally venue. Accommodation lists are available on request.

### **On the day**

All participants will be required to sign a Declaration of Indemnity on the course date prior to participation. In the event that the participant is under 18 years of age, the signature of a parent or guardian will also be required. It is a condition of the disclaimer that all attendees follow the site rules.

GwynneSpeed reserves the right to cancel the course at their sole discretion and either a full refund will be given to you or an alternative date will be offered to you. We will, of course, give as much notice as possible.

Any driver damaging a school car will immediately forfeit all remaining stage activity. There will be no refund whatsoever if this condition is applied.

Alcohol and/or drugs are strictly forbidden from all GwynneSpeed events. GwynneSpeed reserves the right to prevent participation in the course if they have reasonable grounds to consider that the participant is unfit to drive for reasons of health or under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. There will be no refund whatsoever if this condition is applied.

In the event of mechanical problems arising, GwynneSpeed will make every effort to have substitute vehicles on standby. However, in the event that a course is substantially shorter/cancelled due to circumstances beyond GwynneSpeed control, then an alternative date will be offered to you.

Spectators are welcome at GwynneSpeed events. However it is a condition of admission that they shall obey the site rules. Spectators are permitted (time allowing) to have white-knuckle passenger rides, see prices & details in sales literature. For safety, we limit the number of spectators to 3 per driver and no children under 8 years of age. All spectators must stay within the marked areas & children must be supervised at all times. Failure to supervise children will result in them and their guardian being asked to leave the site. Spectators under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible spectating adult.

No pets or animals are allowed on site under any circumstances.

GwynneSpeed holds a specialist motor sport £1 million Third Party Public Liability Insurance, underwritten by Lloyds of London in respect of your course day. However, Motorsport can be hazardous and we strongly advise that you take out separate Personal Accident Insurance. **IMPORTANT** – your personal life cover will probably exclude ALL Motorsport activity.

In the unlikely event that you have any concern or complaint over your day, they must be received in writing within 10 days of the event in our Gloucestershire offices.
